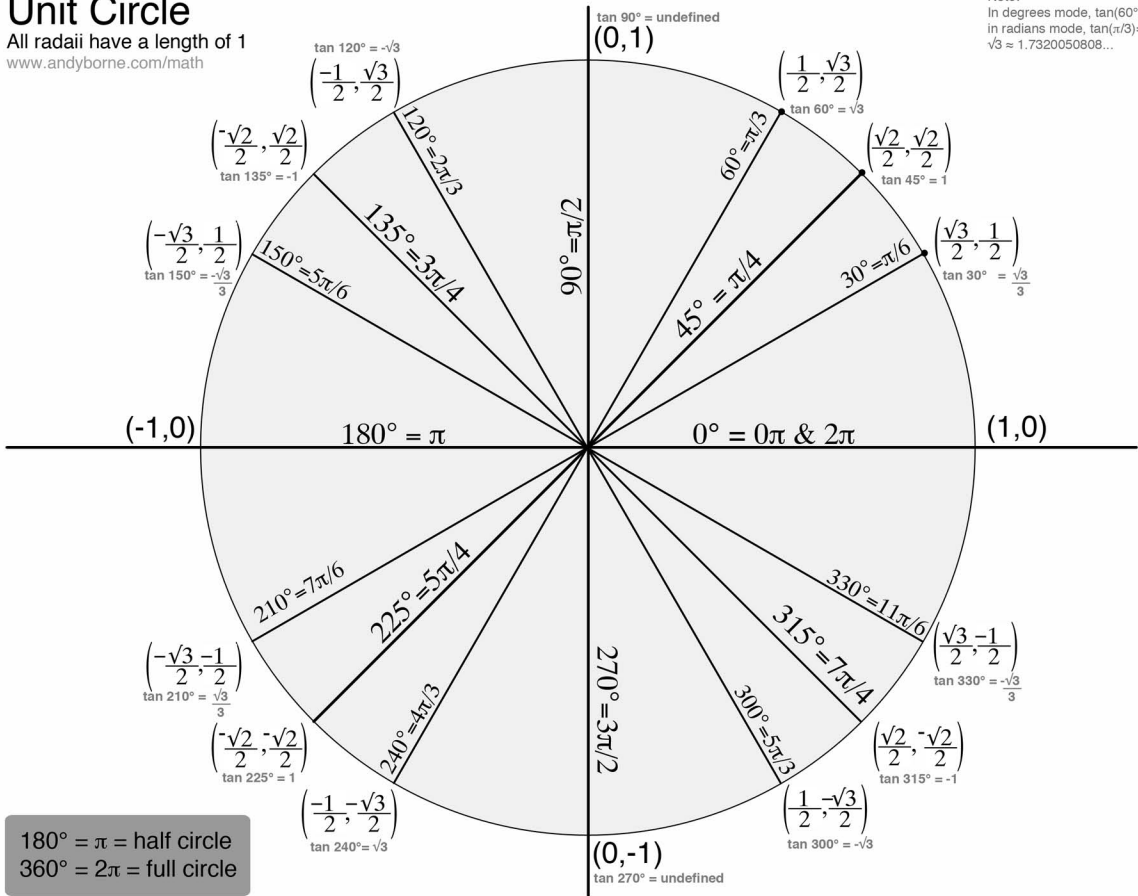


# Unit Circle

Note:  
In degrees mode,  $\tan(60^\circ) = \sqrt{3}$   
in radians mode,  $\tan(\pi/3) = \sqrt{3}$   
 $\sqrt{3} = 1.7320050808...$

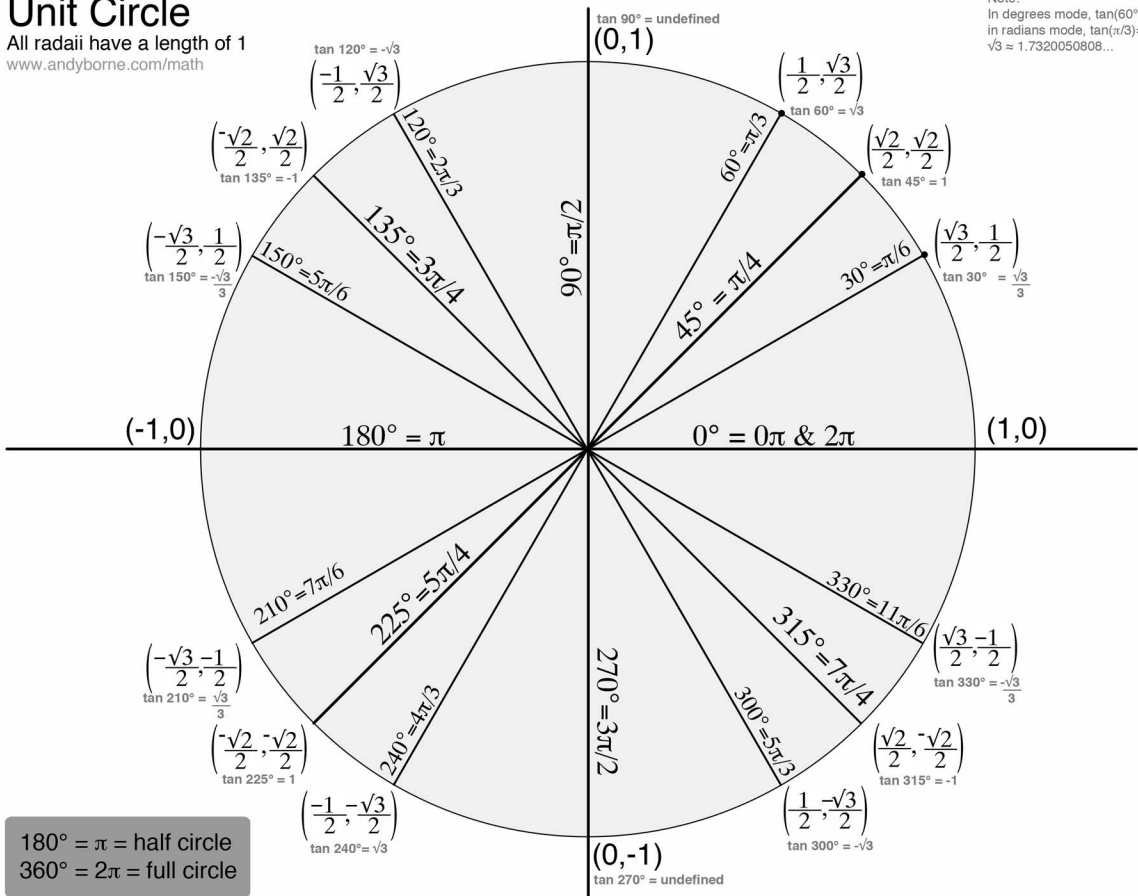


180° = π = half circle  
360° = 2π = full circle

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
